BASIC's Perspective: communiqué of the 8th Ministerial Meeting, 25-27 August, 2011

- AWG-KP:
- Quantified emissions targets for Annex B parties in Kyoto 2nd round and comparable efforts by Annex I parties not in Annex B
- Deepening of commitments towards 2°C
- No gap between Kyoto 1st and 2nd rounds
- Continuity of CDM and flexibility mechanisms
- Concern about "migration" of Annex B parties from KP to AWG-LCA

- Implementation of Cancún decisions and solving of pending issues from Cancún:
- NAMAs registry
- Adaptation
- REDD+
- Technology centers and network
- Green Fund timely disbursement and interim committee under orientation of AWG-LCA
- MRV of QELROs (A.I) and NAMAS (non-A.I)
- MRV of financial commitments (100 bi USD)
- Concern about dangers of unilateralism


