

Promoting an Integrated Knowledge-Base System for Scientific Low-Carbon Development Policymaking in Asia – Part I

- 1. Some universities are in early stage of having dedicated research focus on climate change while others have already being involved and producing advanced research on low carbon approach
- 2. Stronger voice is needed to give higher influence in policy making, thus it is important to have network of research initiatives on similar issues
- 3. Capacity to provide large selections of possible scenario for policy making and coverage of various aspects is important, thus using comprehensive models might be more convincing, especially to policymakers
- 4. There are many limitations in researching for low carbon development scenario, however, focus on specific problem might overcome it, for example in dealing with limited data availability
