


Rate of Forest Cover 2010







<u>Overview</u>

- ◆UN-REDD is a National Joint Programme which coordinates inputs from three UN Agencies FAO, UNDP, and UNEP
- ◆UN-REDD and CAM-REDD is part of the Cambodia REDD+ Programme.
- ◆ The programme's objective is to support Cambodia to be ready for REDD+ implementation, including development of necessary institution, policy, and capacity.






